The Memorial Board has been repositioned to where it is better framed and is awaiting a couple of amendments and additions that have been notified to us, which the History Group have generously offered to organise.

We raised just over £1,000 in donations, which is absolutely AMAZING - what a fantastically generous community we have, thank you so much. This will be put towards purchasing new stage curtains, window dressings and furniture.

All this could not have been done without the massive contribution of all the volunteers who helped from start to finish in so many different respects, with their skills, time, experience, advice, hard work and endless enthusiasm, and in particular Craig, our Chair, who project managed the works and succeeded in getting the Hall OPEN ON TIME!
