

## **Rules & Advice for the Show**

- Please read the schedule carefully.
- The Open Section is open to all age groups
- You can submit entries in as many classes as you wish but only one entry per person per class.
- All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form
- Entries for the show will be accepted on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September between 8 am and 10.30 am. And displayed in the village hall for public viewing from 2pm to 4pm
- Please make sure your entries meet the class specification.
- Where an entry requires more than one item, e.g. 3 apples /vegetables, please try to ensure that they are all as uniform as possible.
- Please display the specified number of fruit, veg, etc.
- Vegetables should be trimmed to 5cm, 2" of foliage where appropriate.
- Vases, baskets, etc., to be supplied by the entrant.
- Judging will commence at 11am when the village hall will be closed.
- All entries must stay on display in the village hall until 4pm.
- From 4pm to 4.15pm entries may be removed but anything left will be auctioned and the proceeds donated to the village hall.
- For the Victoria Sponge - use 3 eggs, jam and butter cream only.
- The Judges' decision is final!

maximum size : 18" x 18" x 18" , 45cm x 45cm x 45cm
  - 15 A foliage pot plant

  - 17 The largest sunflower head
  - 18 One specimen (perfect) flower
  - 19 A bee-friendly posy
  - 20 A bunch of 4 different herbs.
